Firstly, thank you for your interest in The 4th Recycle Challenge based in New Orleans! Join us in celebrating the recycle, repurpose, and upcycling crafting culture. As part of your participation, it is essential to note that you must obtain a vendor permit from the City of New Orleans. The vendor Occupational Permit cost is \$50.00 via onestopapp.nola.gov, or you can download the A Supplement on our web page. With this permit it allows vendors to utilize through the 2025 year.

If you select to vend with us, your vendor payment must be paid first and received by **April 14th, 2025.** See the attached:

- Vendors are required to maintain a sales report and calculate 10% of their generated sales, which must be paid by the end of the vending experience on either, April 17, 2025, or for the April 30, 2025, Walking Parade - Before or After Party experience.
- Checks payable to: The City of New Orleans for sales tax of 10% on what sales were generated.



- All food and beverage vendors must comply with local health and safety regulations.
- Setup time will be assigned on the day of the event; no early breakdowns are permitted.
- Vendors must remain open for the duration of the event.
