Sewing: Semi-Advanced

Sewing 102: Semi-Advanced is for people that have taken the Beginner Sewing/Sewing 101: Basics classes or are experienced sewists and know how to sew. You will learn how to make a drawstring skirt or drawstring pants from a commercial pattern. This class is also a project based class. Meaning you can come in with projects you would like to learn how to do (i.e hems, fixing zipper, button placements, curtain projects, etc.).

During this course you will learn:

- · all of the necessary sewing terminology & equipment
- · how to read a basic commercial pattern
- · how to choose the right fabric for a garment--either a skirt or drawstring pants
- · various types of stitches & seam finishes using a sewing machine!

SUPPLIES: Sewing supplies will be included and we will be using the same pattern for the class and includes S,M,L. Please let us know if you would like a plus size pattern as we also have those options

COURSE DURATION: 4 Hours (split into 2 - 2 hr classes - once per week)

PREREQUISITE: Must know basic sewing
